MATERIAL AND SUPPLY INFORMATION

- Charcoal, preferably compressed.
- Charcoal pencils, colored pencils, markers, etc.
- India ink
- Erasers
- Metal ruler 2 ft. or longer
- Utility knife
- White artists tape or masking tape
- Drawing pad or loose sheets 16x20" or larger
- Brushes a comfortable, pleasing to hold small to medium size flat or round bristle brush.
- At least one, somewhat unattractive brush.
- Scissors
- Glue stick
