



Creating an Abstract Watercolor Nan Rumpf

Please bring the following materials to this workshop

- your usual watercolor painting supplies (paints, brushes, rinse water containers, paper towels, palette for mixing colors, misting bottle etc.)
- 2 or 3 sheets of watercolor paper (Fabriano, or Sauders Waterford preferred) 12" X 18" or larger.
- a backboard a little larger than your watercolor paper.
- 7 sheets of tracing paper (each a little larger than your watercolor paper)
- a tube of white watercolor gouache (Winsor Newton Permanent White is good)
- a 2B pencil
- a kneaded eraser, and a white pencil eraser
- a scissors
- masking or artists tape
- a permanent black marker
- a ruler (the longest one you have)
- a sketch book for testing values and colors.
