

Creating an Abstract Watercolor

Please bring the following materials to this workshop

• Your usual watercolor painting supplies (paints, brushes, rinse water containers, paper towels, palette for mixing colors, misting bottle etc.)

• 2 or 3 sheets of watercolor paper (Fabriano, or Sauders Waterford preferred) 12" X 18" or larger.

• Backboard a little larger than your watercolor paper.

• 7 sheets of tracing paper (each a little larger than your watercolor paper)

• A tube of white watercolor gouache (Winsor Newton Permanent White is good)

- 2B pencil
- kneaded eraser, and a white pencil eraser
- Scissors
- masking or artists tape
- Permanent black marker
- Ruler (the longest one you have)
- A sketch book for testing values and colors.
