

**Watercolor on Masa
(Crinkled Paper Technique)
This is a single session 4 hour workshop**

Sometimes working on a new surface and learning new techniques can get you out of an artistic rut and rekindle your enthusiasm. Come join us as we work explore a new way of working on crinkled Japanese paper. Methods of flattening and mounting a finished painting will also be demonstrated.

- Masa paper – you can order it at Blicks www.dickblick.com 1-800-426-6740
(or you can purchase some from the instructor if you bring cash or check)
- a clean nonabsorbent backboard (like plexi)
- watercolor paints and brushes
- a misting bottle
- a roll of paper towels
- water jar or other container for rinsing brushes
- 2B pencil and a kneaded eraser
- an inexpensive sketchbook (for planning paintings and testing colors)
- white plate, tray or palette lid for mixing colors
- an old clean bath towel (one that you don't mind getting paint on)
