



Not So Still Life- Jill Pottle

(Suggested, not required)

Pick Oil or Acrylic painting. Not both

Acrylic Painting:

- 1.5" house painting brushes &/or sponge brushes)
- Pallet knife
- Acrylic Medium (not gel)
- Acrylic Retarder
- paper towels
- paper pallet **or** roll of Freezer Paper
- plastic wrap (suggested),
- container for water
- cup for medium
- spray bottle (suggested)
- masking tape
- suggested three brushes - #10 and up, round, flat and filbert, (long handles)
- Feel free to bring what every other brushes you wish

My favorite brand of paint: Golden or Windsor Newton. Or cheap paints Big tubes of Basics or Soho paints.

Oil Painting

- Same with brushes as above
- paper pallet or freezer paper
- Murphy's Oil soap (suggested brush cleaner)
- paper towels
- pallet knife
- masking tape
- plastic wrap (suggested)
- paint cups
- The oil painting medium: pick only one: Gamblin odorless gel or Professional Walnut oil with alkyd. No premixed oil mediums.
- 2 glass jars with metal tops
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NO SOLVENTS or citrus products to be used in class, *Safflower Oil*, will be used for cleaning brushes in between colors. Water base oils are fine. Regular oil paint brands: Gamblin, Grumbacher, Windsor Newton

PAINT COLORS: Cadmium Red Medium

Cad. Yellow Medium,

Ultramarine Blue, large tube of Titanium White,

Suggested other colors you might consider:

- Alizarin Crimson or Rose madder or Quinacridone Magenta
- Cad. Yellow. Light Cad. or Lemon Yellow Cad.
- Yellow Ochre
- Cerulean Blue
- Manganese or Cobalt Blue

PLEASE NOTE FOR ALL OIL PAINTERS

- Do not pour any oils down sink.

- All Oil painters liquid waste goes home with you. Bring in glass jar!!!!
