## Materials:

### General Supplies

- watercolor paper whatever type of paper you like to use but it should be good quality 140 LB paper (Arches, Fabiano and Waterford are all good quality paper)
- plexiglass or other non-absorbent backboards... slightly larger than the WC paper size...(a drawing backboard would also work)
- bring 2 pieces of paper and 2 backboards so you can be experiment on 2 paintings at once.
- watercolor paints (tubes work best for the washes - but palette paints can also be useful)
- watercolor brushes
- 2 water containers (one for rinsing brushes, one for pre-wetting paper)
- white palette or plate for mixing colors
- a muffin tin to prepare wash colors
- paper towels
- misting bottle
- sketch paper (for testing colors and values)
- tape (for attaching paper to backboard)

### Please bring the following important items:

- Plastic wrap



- Press and Seal wrap
- Tacing paper as large as your watercolor paper
