

Acrylic Ink and Watercolor Workshop

Notes:

Due to supply chain issues, a kit that includes Daler-Rowney acrylic ink (sepia and burnt umber, 1 oz bottle) and Winsor and Newton granulation medium (2.5 oz) will be provided for students.

Materials:

- □ Watercolor paper, several sheets 11x14 or smaller
- □ Paint, use what you like
 - □ The colors I'll be using are raw sienna, burnt sienna, transparent yellow and quinacridone gold, alizarin crimson, cobalt blue and ultramarine blue (Winsor and Newton Artist grade)
- Synthetic brushes
- Small spray bottle
- Water container
- Tissues or paper towels

Materials (Optional):

- Mr. Clean Magic Eraser
- □ Thin plastic sheet, clear or tinted, plastic or acetate (such as used in presentation covers)
- □ Retractable snap off utility knife (box cutter)
- Hair dryer
- □ Apron, smock, or old clothes
- Masking fluid and liquid soap, old brush (I don't use this in this workshop but you might want to)
