

Asian Paper Collage

Materials:

A couple of sheets of watercolor paper
(140 LB cold press works well Arches, Waterford, Fabiano or whatever kind of watercolor
paper and size you prefer)
Back boards slightly larger than your paper (You can use still cardboard)
Watercolor paints (artist quality preferred)
Watercolor brushes
A misting bottle
Paper towels
Artist tape or masking tape
Water jar or other container for rinsing brushes
An inexpensive sketchbook (for planning paintings and testing colors)
Kneaded eraser and pencil
Watercolor palette with large mixing area or a white plate for mixing colors
PVA glue (an acid balanced book binding glue available at fine art stores and online)
A variety of Asian papers (rice paper) if you have any (A variety will also be provided)
An inexpensive brush for applying glue
A small section of brown cardboard or a colored plastic plate for mixing glue
Any Asian papers you might have
