Notes:

- ☐ Please do not bring Phoenix brand acrylic from the Job Lot to the classroom – they have a toxic smell that some people are allergic to.

Materials:

- ☐ Paint colors in order of their importance
 - ☐ Cadmium yellow, medium
 - ☐ Cadmium red, medium
 - ☐ Cobalt blue
 - ☐ White
 - ☐ Phthalo green
 - ☐ Phthalo blue
 - ☐ Ultramarine blue
 - ☐ Alizarin crimson
 - ☐ Black
 - ☐ Violet
 - ☐ Burnt sienna

- ☐ Raw umber
- ☐ Ochre, yellow
- ☐ Large Palette (disposable pad with palette sheets is best)
- ☐ Palette knife
- ☐ Pad of canvas paper
- ☐ Stretched canvas or canvas board
- ☐ Brushes (natural bristle) of various sizes – at least three (1", 1/2" 1/8")
- ☐ Acrylic gloss medium (for acrylic users only)
- ☐ Ruler
- ☐ Pencil
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Roll of paper towels
- ☐ Jar for water
