\Box Inexpensive bound sketch pad, 8" x 10" or 9" x 12"
☐ H, HB and 2B graphite pencils
☐ Kneaded and plastic erasers
☐ Masking tape, light colored
□ Board or surface to tape paper onto
\square A minimum of 8 professional-quality tubes of watercolor
paint; small size tube is fine from Winsor & Newton
brand. Suggested colors that mix nicely for landscapes
or use what colors you already have:
☐ Lemon Yellow
□ Naples Yellow
□ Scarlet Lake
☐ Permanent Rose

☐ French Ultramarine
☐ Cobalt Blue
□ Burnt Sienna
☐ Optional but strongly suggested:
□ Winsor Blue Green Shade
□ Winsor Violet (Dioxazine)
☐ Antwerp Blue
\square OR a set of professional quality watercolor paints in a
pan format
\square Palette to mix colors
\square Synthetic Rounds Brushes, sizes #2, #4, #6, #10, plus a
very small brush for details such as size 3/0 or other,
