



Dripped Wax Resist with Watercolor

Materials:

- ☐ **Several sheets of watercolor paper (140 LB cold press)
(You can buy it in blocks or in separate sheets and cut to desired size)**
- ☐ **2 or 3 stiff supportive backboards slightly larger than your paper (stiff cardboard works)**
- ☐ **Artist tape or masking tape**
- ☐ **Watercolor paint (artist grade preferred)**
- ☐ **Watercolor brushes including a wash brush**
- ☐ **Misting/Spray bottle**
- ☐ **Roll of paper towels**
- ☐ **2 water jar or other container for rinsing brushes and prewetting paper**
- ☐ **2B pencil and a kneaded eraser**
- ☐ **Inexpensive sketchbook (for planning paintings and testing colors)**
- ☐ **White plate, tray or watercolor palette for mixing colors**

- ☐ Containers for pooling separate wash colors (plastic cups or bowls or a muffin tin with areas openings large enough for your wash brush)
- ☐ Small sea sponge
