Materials:

- ☐ \$5 Materials fee paid to instructor on day of workshop
- ☐ [Clean non-absorbent backboard](#)
 - ☐ (Plexi works well or a hard-shell drawing board or a clean cookie sheet)
- ☐ [Watercolor paints](#) and [brushes](#) (a couple of flat brushes would be handy)
- ☐ You can also use Chinese Brush painting [paints](#) and [brushes](#).
- ☐ [Misting bottle](#)
- ☐ Roll of paper towels
- ☐ Water container for rinsing your brushes
- ☐ A 2B or 3B [pencil](#) and a [kneaded eraser](#)
- ☐ Inexpensive [sketchbook](#) for planning and for testing color mixes
- ☐ White plate, tray or palette lid for mixing colors
- ☐ Old clean flat bath towel (not a good one as you may get paint on it) or felt
